

INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS

ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27



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All prospective students who hold a **foreign qualification** (non-Italian system) are considered international students. Procedures may differ depending on whether you are:

- a **non-European student applying for a study visa (Visa student)**;
- an **Italian, European or equivalent student** already residing in Italy or in another European country.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

The admission process consists of different steps, which vary depending on your status.

- 1) **PRE-EVALUATION: all international students** must submit a pre-assessment application to be admitted in a UNIVPM program. This also applies to students with foreign degrees who are already enrolled in another Italian University and want to apply for transfer at UNIVPM.

The preliminary assessment consists of two stages: in the first stage, the committee for each course of study assesses the student's personal preparation and consistency with their previous academic background; the second stage involves a formal verification of the qualification in relation to its equivalence with Italian qualifications and the authenticity of the documentation provided.

- 2) **PRE-ENROLMENT: Visa students** need to submit a pre-enrolment application in the national portal www.Universitaly.it to request for study visa. Please review the [ministerial circular](#) and the requirements for the issue of a study-enrolment visa before applying.
- 3) **ADMISSION TEST FOR RESTRICTED ACCESS PROGRAMMES:** Some programs (eg. Medicine and Surgery) have a local or national quota, meaning that to gain access, one must pass an admission test and be awarded one of the available places. Admission rules and deadlines are governed by specific notices available on our main website www.univpm.it
- 4) **ENROLMENT:** The last step is the enrolment phase, scheduled to begin in mid-July 2026. **Visa students** must have obtained a student visa to begin the matriculation application. Further info in the dedicated pages.

IMPORTANT NOTICE ON ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATIONS

- Each application is assessed individually based on different elements (e.g. academic performance, previous studies, motivation, adequate preparation etc.). Possession of the academic and language requirements indicated in this document is **NOT a guarantee of admission**.
- Before applying, please check our list of [international qualifications valid for enrollment \(by Country\)](#)
- The assessment is valid only for the year 2026-27, and previous assessments will not be considered, as requirements may change over time.



ADMISSION DEADLINES

International students may submit **a maximum of two applications for different courses**.

NOTE WELL:

- **Master's degree in Ingegneria elettronica** will be offered with a double curricula in Italian and English starting from the **2nd CALL**.
- **New programs or curricula** may be added from the **2nd CALL**.
- Applications for **restricted access programs** (eg. Medicine and Surgery...) can be submitted starting from the 3rd CALL, in coordination with the publication of admission notices.

- If the program is free access, if an interview or knowledge test is required, or if the program is restricted access (admission test required),
- If the program is restricted access, verify if you're eligible to participate to the competition;
- Some programs may offer a double o joint degree.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS a.y. 2026/27

ENGLISH TAUGHT PROGRAMS

English language proficiency of **B2 CEFR level** is required for admission.

Please, be aware that the ways in which this requirement can be demonstrated may differ depending on the course of study. **Check the dedicated page carefully to find out what documentation or proof is required** for the course you are interested in:

Failure to demonstrate the language requirements may result in rejection of the application or non-admission.

ITALIAN TAUGHT PROGRAMS

Italian language proficiency of **B2 CEFR level** is required for admission.

Requirement can be demonstrated by:

- Attending and passing an Italian proficiency test organized by our Centre for Language Support (CSAL)
- Submitting an Italian certificate among those issued by one of the CLIQ institutions: PLIDA, CELI, CERTIT, CILS.
- Submitting a certificate of passing ITA-L2 Bravo! tests (CISIA) taken at other universities in the year 2026 and passed with the minimum score of 43/72.

Note well: in addition to proficiency in Italian, knowledge of English or another EU common language (French or German or Spanish) is required for master's degree programs. Check the additional requirement for your course [here](#).

Pay attention: failure to demonstrate the language requirements results in rejection of the application or non-admission.



HOW TO APPLY

1. Go to [UNIVPM.GOMOVEIN](https://univpm.gomovein.it)

2. Register/Login to the portal:

New users:

- insert your **complete name and surname** as it appears on your passport or ID;
- Please, remember to **use the same email address for all the procedures regarding the admission.**
- Make sure you have **access to your account and email box to receive our communications!**
- Write correctly the **number of your passport or ID as this identifies** your application.

Old users: If you already have an account, click on LOGIN and use your old credentials or request a password reset.

3. First, you'll be asked to complete a **personal data form**: please, complete with attention every part, as this information is relevant to your application. Once completed all fields, submit the form and then go on to **start the admission application** for the first-choice program.

If you require a study VISA, please, reply Yes to the proper question.

Once submitted the personal data form, you'll be able to start the application for the chosen program.

4. **First-choice program application**: the application is composed of different sections. When a section is completed, a green check symbol appears:

a. Program choice: select your program, according to the teaching language and program level. Be careful, as once the application is submitted you cannot change program.

b. Personal details: you can review and add some personal details (as contact address and embassy) in this section.

c. Languages: according to the selected program you'll be asked to provide Italian or English proficiency requirements and add eventual certificates.

Before submitting the application, **please verify that you possess the right language**

Be aware, that for master's degree held in Italian language an additional language knowledge is required (check page 10 of this guide).

NOTE WELL: we verify the authenticity and validity of each language certificate in the portal of certifying bodies. **Application with fraudulent certificates and with certificates different from those accepted will be rejected.** In case of expired certificates, you'll be asked to send an integration within 45 days.

- d. Education:** in this section you must describe and upload all your relevant secondary school and/or academic qualifications required for the admission.

Please, visit our [guide on minimum requirements and qualifications by Country](#) to check if your qualification is suitable.

Note well: If the Institution that awarded your diploma or degree provided you with a document(s) which contain security features that make the **documents digitally verifiable in a secure way**, please upload such original digital document(s).

PLEASE, UPLOAD OR SCAN DOCUMENTS OF YOUR QUALIFICATIONS IN COLOR AND DOUBLE-SIDED, WITH ALL RELEVANT SIGNATURE AND STAMPS VISIBLE.

In case your qualifications already have a legalization or apostille, upload all the relevant pages. If you already have a DECLARATION OF VALUE or CIMEA certificates of comparability and verification, we strongly encourage you to upload them. This may speed up the verification of your application.

- **Applicants for admission to a bachelor's degree:** a high school diploma (or equivalent qualification) earned with **at least 12 years of schooling** is required. Note that, according to the regulations of your Country, we could take into consideration a cut off score.

You must upload also the marksheet or transcript of at least the LAST 2 YEARS of your high school career, with an indication of a grade scale. Indication of a grade scale can be very important for the purpose of obtaining future benefits should you be admitted.

Please, specify also the **actual or future achievement date** and the **education system to which your diploma belongs:** for example, if you are a Pakistani citizen but have obtained a diploma with an English curriculum, select UK as the education system.

You must also submit a **National University Entrance examination certificate** if this kind of examination is mandatory in the Country where your diploma has been issued.

Qualifications obtained with 10 or 11 years of schooling: if you have less



than 12 years of schooling, you must demonstrate the completion of 1 or 2 integration year(s) in an officially recognized Higher Education Institution: e.g. foundation year, or one complete year of a bachelor's degree (etc..) with all credits earned (correspondent to 60 ects credits). In these cases, you need to **upload a complete transcript and a statement from your University attesting that you've completed all credits provided in the first year.**

- **Applicants for admission to a bachelor's degree:** a bachelor's degree (or equivalent qualification) or additional academic qualifications **corresponding at least to the EQF level 6 (European Qualification Framework).**

The University that issued your degree must be **officially accredited** at the time of the award of your degree. Please, if you cannot find the name of your University in the dropdown menu, you can type "other", then fill the name of your University in the blank field.

Please, specify the actual or future achievement date.

You must upload also the full transcript or diploma supplement of your academic career with an indication of a grade scale. Indication of a grade scale can be very important for the purpose of obtaining future benefits should you be admitted.

- e. **Professional experience:** You can add your cv (not mandatory) and other work experience you think would be helpful to submit to the academic commission.
- f. **Motivation:** Tell us why you want to enrol in your chosen course of study, what your expectations are and how you came to know about our university.
- g. **Application fee:** A fee of 10 euros is required for each application submitted. You can pay by credit card from major banking circuits.
- h. **Final submission: PLEASE, SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION ONCE YOU'RE SURE THAT ALL MANDATORY AND RELEVANT DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN UPLOADED.**

If you applied through an agent, we suggest you verify that your application is successful and to have access to your personal area.

Once submitted you will be able to download the application summary.

5. **Second-choice program application:** You can apply for a second course other than the first, for the same academic year, within the assessment windows. The steps to follow are the same as in Step 4.
6. **Interview form:** Some courses of study require participation in an interview or test. If you receive an invitation to the interview from your chosen course commission, you can book the time and date of the interview or test through the move-in portal.
7. **Conversation section:** In the conversations section you can find all the emails received from the admission portal. You can reply to the email received at admission.support@sm.univpm.it We suggest that you verify your email or access the



portal yourself.

OUTCOMES OF THE PRE-ADMISSION APPLICATION

Due to the elevate number of applicants, it may take **a minimum of 45 days** to receive the outcome. We kindly ask you to wait patiently and refrain from sending reminder emails.

Should we need to request additional documents or clarification, we will contact you.

Please, note that if you're a VISA applicant, in case of admission or admission under condition, the official pre-admission LETTER will be sent once we validate your pre-enrolment application on the University portal.

UNIVERSITALY PRE-ENROLMENT (VISA applicants)

International students applying for a study visa, following successful pre-admission, must submit a pre-enrolment application on the University ministerial portal.

Note well: before submitting your pre-enrolment application, we encourage you to **review the ministerial circular governing admission for students applying for a study-enrolment visa**, published on April 30th, 2026, as **several new provisions have been introduced that we invite you to carefully consider** (quotas, financial and housing requirements, mandatory documentation to be submitted to the embassy/consulate, see pages 16-18).

In particular, **the following academic documents are required when applying for a visa at the Embassy** and **we strongly encourage** to provide them in the pre-enrolment application to quick its validation:

1. **Entrance qualification and marksheet or transcript or diploma supplement** (the same provided in the pre-admission portal), **both in original language and sworn translation into English or Italian. All pages in colour, front and back must be provided and with evidence of any eventual authentication stamps.**
2. **CIMEA Comparability statement**, or **ARDI** correspondence statement (only for signatory countries to the Lisbon convention). As alternative, you can provide **Declaration of Value** issued by the Italian Embassy or Consulate located in the country where the qualification was awarded.
3. **CIMEA statement of Verification** or, as alternative, **Apostille or legalization** issued by the Italian embassy or consulate in the country where the qualification has been awarded. In this last case, both the original qualification and its translation must be legalized or apostilled and ALL pages must be provided.
4. **Language proficiency certification of B2 level**, depending on the language of instruction of the program, issued by an international recognized institution. As alternative, a statement of passing a proficiency test, organized by the University, that assess all the four competences (oral/written comprehension and oral/written production)



5. Additional documents :

- Academic entrance examination: If mandatory in the country where the diploma was awarded (ex: Gao-Kao for China, Vestibular or ENEM in Brazil, YKS in Turkey, UTME in Nigeria ...)
- Compensation year(s) for diplomas obtained with less than 12 years of schooling: **provide both** an official transcript and statement confirming the successful completion of the first year (or two years) of university. Alternatively, you can provide a Foundation Year certificate (compensating 1 year) from a foreign or Italian university, or a post-secondary qualification from a recognized institution.

VISA applicants will receive their letter of admission at the same time as their pre-enrolment application is verified and validated on the University portal.

Please, note that only applications validated without conditions will be accepted by the Embassy, with the exception of those applying for restricted access programs and those who have still to obtain their qualification. **For this reason, it's important you provide documentation or proof of authenticity** (legalisation/apostille or verification certificate from CIMEA, or provide information on digital tools for online verification of qualifications).

Once we have validated your application, **you will receive a summary of your pre-enrolment application through the UNIVERSITY portal** that you will have to present to the Italian Embassy or Consulate in your Country. The visa procedure may vary according to the provisions issued by each Italian Embassy or Consulate abroad and it is the candidate's responsibility to inquire about specific procedures and deadlines. **Make sure you arrive at your appointment with the embassy with all the required documentation**, to avoid your visa application being rejected. Visa request must be completed by the deadline established by the Italian Ministry of University set on 30th November 2026. Please, check procedures and deadlines for limited access courses.
